Drone 'Netra' to keep surveillance on Amarnath Yatra: CRPF

Jammu, Jun 28 (UNI) Asserting that no stone left unturned to provide security to the Amarnath pilgrims, CRPF officials today said that drone 'Netra' will be keeping surveillance on 40-day long pilgrimage flagged off by the Jammu and Kashmir Deputy Chief Minister Dr Nirmal Singh from Yatri Niwas base camp here.

Considering the law and order situation in J&K and in Kashmir valley in particular, the force has left no stone unturned to take up the challenge, Jammu based CRPF spokesman here said.

He said, "the surveillance of every inch is being kept by the vigilant eyes of CPRF jawans which is further strengthened by the use of drone 'Netra'."

"To facilitate the pilgrims, CRPF has also established 'Sahayata booth' at various places while the force has also established medical camp en route to provide free medical treatment to the pilgrims," said the spokesman.
