

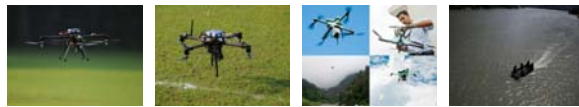

Unmanned aerial vehicle Netra will scout for bodies of engineering students from Hyderabad who drowned in river Beas in Himachal Pradesh. The UAV, a prized possession of the NDRF 5th battalion, was used for search operations during the last year. "Netra can fly 2.5 km from take-off point and to a height of 100m with a battery back-up of 30 minutes. In case of a small malfunction or battery discharge, built-in fail-safe system allows it to return to take-off point even if communication is lost
